

The Clown in the Mirror

A Short funny (clown) skit.
Two clowns, any age will do.
A window frame

Clown 1---His body is moving up and down and he's scratching himself really bad, as if he has a bad itch. He scratches his arms and then his legs, and starts to scratch his face and then grabs one of his hands with the other one and shakes his head No! He pulls it with the other hand away from his face.

Clown 2---Comes out and looks at clown 1 and starts to do the same thing and scratching himself and does exactly the same thing.

Clown 1---- Looks at him like he is nuts. He then stops scratching himself.

Clown 2---Shrugs his shoulders and looks at the other clown like he is nuts and stops scratching himself.

Clown 1---Goes over to the pretend mirror. You can use a window frame and pretend it's a mirror.

Clown 2--- Also goes over to the mirror but is on the opposite side of Clown 1.

Clown 1--- Puts his hand on the mirror at the same time that clown 2 does and they go in the same direction with their hands, first in a circle following each other, and then in the opposite way. They will need to hold their hands up and not through the window sill so it can

look like a reflection a mirror. They can pretend that they are shaving and washing their faces. They must do everything at the same time. (Rehearse this well!)

Clown 1---- Thinks he's looking at himself in the mirror. This goes on for a few minutes, until one of them messes up and it scares them both that their hand is not doing what the hand in the mirror is doing. At that point both clowns turn around and run like crazy because it scared them both. They run in opposite directions right off the stage.
